Impressions from Three ABM Students Internship at Goodvalley, Poland

Karl, Rune and Oliver have just finalized a 2-month long internship at Goodvalley, Poland in the spring 2023. It is part of their study at Business Academy Aarhus, Denmark to become Agro Business Manager (ABM).

During our internship at Goodvalley, we were at first introduced to the facilities with sows, piglets, and fattening pigs. In addition, we also saw a feed factory, a slaughterhouse, and the head office. Once we had gained an impression and the significance of the company, we were given some small projects about the sows and optimization of feed intake by the piglets. We had to be responsible for trials and tests ourselves. In addition, we had to get the Polish employees involved in the tasks involved during the experiments.

During our stay at Goodvalley we also experienced a bit of Polish culture and were invited to a local party. We attended several meetings, both internal production meetings, but also with external sellers and consultants.
